ACTION:

The Bowling Green-Warren County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) hereby modifies the FY 2016-2020 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to revise the funding for Fiscal Year 2016 to add the project listed below. The project being added is classified as a Grouped Project within the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) project type.

TAP – Transportation Alternatives Program

PROJECT ID: 2016-17

DESCRIPTION: Funding for this project will pay for construction of a new greenway path connecting Moss Middle School to an existing greenway in a low-income, high residential area on Creekwood Drive. The project will include a bridge over Jennings Creek, lighting, benches and a trailhead marker. It will include construction of a new sidewalk and a new 8 ft. wide greenway path. The greenway will be 0.25 miles in length.

PHASE: Design, Construction

TYPE OF FUND: TAP

FY: 2016

AMOUNT: \$177,474

Other Information:

The identification of Grouped Projects involves a commitment of additional funding by the project sponsor (Kentucky Transportation Cabinet). The additional funding maintains financial constraint of the TIP and MTP documents, and no additional financial constraint analysis by the MPO is needed. A listing of Grouped Projects has been included in the TIP allowing planning process stakeholders and the general public to be informed of the types of potential projects that may be added to the TIP and MTP by Administrative Modification. TIP actions for these projects will not require additional public review.


