## 1. CALL TO ORDER

Ms. Lemon introduced the first item of business to discuss the recent Bicycle Friendly Community workshop that was held on May 9-10 in Bowling Green. Many of the meeting participants were part of the workshop, thus Ms. Lemon asked for all who attended the meeting to provide their takeaways from the workshop. Discussion was had on various matters on how to help Bowling Green become more bicycle friendly.

Ms. Lemon suggested to the group to continue consistency of the workshop action planning meetings to pursue some of the ideas discussed. It was stated that the group will meet the second Wednesdays of each month at 3:00 pm. These meetings will be working meetings to implement action items/focus areas from the workshop.

#### 5. INFORMATIONAL ITEMS & PROJECT UPDATES

Kyle Hunt, Bowling Green Public Works, and Nick Cook, Bowling Green Neighborhood and Community Services, provided updates on City bicycle and pedestrian improvements. The College Street pedestrian bridge was awarded \$2.3 million for maintenance and repair work, which will begin soon. The West End greenway project from Kentucky Street to Hobson Grove Park is waiting for remaining funds to be authorized prior to construction bids going out. College Street will soon undergo a lane reconfiguration similar to State Street, with sidewalk improvements and a bicycle lane. A shared use path is funded on Smallhouse Road from Campbell Lane to Thimblefinger Way, along with shared use paths on Bryant Way and Lovers Lane (extending from The Hub to Searcy Way).
