1. CALL TO ORDER

Staff member Carroll Duckworth called the meeting to order and initiated introductions.

2. REVIEW/ACCEPT SUMMARY NOTES – February 12, 2024

There were no additions or corrections to the summary notes from the February 12, 2024 BPAC meeting.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

The following comments/questions/concerns were presented and briefly discussed by the members:

- Amber Kelleher - Small sinkhole in middle of greenway at corner of Lover's Ln. and Cemetery Rd.
- Jon Fox - Status of the lighting project at Riverview Drive and Center St. Funding has been received and project is has been delayed due to change in city staff. Concern of greenway path along Cemetery Rd. being used by golf carts. Suggestion of bollards to hinder golf cart use on greenways
- Jon Fox - Pavement marking/signage along Cemetery Road are worn and need replacement.
- Ryan Pattee - Safety of Hampton and Cemetery Rd. intersection at entrance to Kereiakes Park. Suggestions included roundabout and improved pedestrian crossing signals.
- Ryan Pattee - Median island located on Gary Farms Blvd at intersection of Scottsville Rd. causes pedestrians to walk around the island either into on-coming traffic on Gary Farms or into traffic on Scottsville Rd. Suggest a cut through be installed.
- Ryan Pattee - Vehicles parking on Shawnee block the bike lane.
- Ben Hunt - Why do parks have fences around them limiting access to and from adjoining neighborhoods?
- Jon Fox - Inquired about the status of the green paint on bike paths.

4. BUSINESS ITEMS

- Ben Hunt provided an update on the Scottsville Rd. multiuse pathway
- Carroll Duckworth provided updates on the following items: Metropolitan Transportation Plan being updated; Bicycle & Pedestrian 2024 Prioritization Process which needs to be updated by end of year; and Upcoming Paula Nye Grant Memorial Grant Application due in October.
- Carroll Duckworth present some thought on BPAC Committee Restructuring/Membership which resulted a lengthy discussion among the group. Suggestions include: changing name from BPAC to BikeWalkBG Advisory Committee; review time and date of meetings; how to increase participation; communication meeting time/dates (press release, flyers, BikeWalkBG distribution list); committee vs attendees; committee purpose and goals. A possible supplemental meeting may be added to the schedule to discuss these items.
- Carroll Duckworth and Natasha Smith provided updates on the following: Bicycle Education Program – Progress and Action Items; Review of Spring/Summer events; Securement of new bicycles; Volunteer efforts, Bike Walk Summit Kentucky 2024 take aways.
