

# MPO Policy Committee Summary Minutes August 26, 2025 Meeting

Warren County Judge-Executive Doug Gorman called the MPO Policy Committee to order.

- 1. Roll Call A roll call was conducted in order to determine a quorum; quorum was determined with all members present.
- 2. Approval of Summary Minutes There was no discussion regarding the June 24, 2025 meeting minutes. Mayor Todd Alcott made a motion to approve the June 24, 2025 minutes. Seconded by Ben Hunt, All in favor, so approved.
