- h. Safe Routes to School – work started in February with Briarwood and Jennings Creek Elementary Schools.
- i. Grants/Funding
 - Spark Grant submitted for \$2,000 was denied
 - Paula Nye Memorial Grant Application Award announced – Received \$8,700 of the \$10,833 requested.
 - Safe Streets for All (SS4A) – exploring possibilities, need match. Jake Moore update the group stating a Safety Action Plan is required and since it is still in draft form, an application may not be possible.

6. Public Comment/Concern –

- A. Center for Accessible Living (CAL), has relocated to 1600 Scottsville Rd, A CAL client has voiced a concern regarding the safety of the bus stop directly in front of CAL’s building for especially those who are blind or require the use of mobility devices (wheelchairs/canes/walkers.) Can improvements we made to bring this location make it safer and more user friendly? See photos. Discussion was conducted on various issues and challenges. A suggestion was made to relocate



the bus stop to a flat paved surface on South Fork. Jake Moore stated that he had an upcoming meeting with Transit that would include this concern.

- B. Discussion continued about other items/locations that were a concern:
- Pedestrian buttons with limited access for individuals with mobility devices.
 - Russellville Rd – Sidewalk ends between McDonalds to liquor store.
 - SKY Rehab – bus stop in the grass on Patrick Way.
