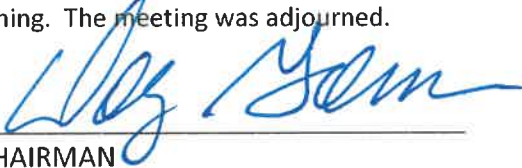
1. **Carroll Duckworth, MPO Coordinator called the MPO Policy Committee to order.**
2. **Roll Call** - A roll call was conducted in order to determine a quorum; quorum was determined with all members present.
3. **Approval of April 28, 2026 Summary Minutes:** There was no discussion regarding the 4/28/26 meeting minutes. Todd Alcott made a motion to approve the 4/28/26 minutes and seconded by Joe Plunk.  - A. Approve revision to the Policy Committee Officer Election MPO Bylaws to be presented for approval at the June meeting. Todd Alcott made a motion to approve the proposal and Bryan Downing seconded. All in favor, so approved.
 - B. Approve contract for the Transit Development Plan in the amount of \$120K. Joe Plunk made a motion to approve the proposal and Todd Alcott seconded. All in favor, so approved.
 - C. Approve contract for GoBG Transit Marketing Support in the amount of \$45K for FY 2027. Bryan Downing made a motion to approve the proposal and Joe Plunk seconded. All in favor, so approved.

 - g. The City and GoBG Transit are working to inventory and address bus stops that are not ADA compliant.

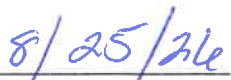
- h. Title VI annual training completed for all CCPC/MPO staff.
- B. Bicycle Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC)

 - b. Celebrated League of American Bicyclists naming Bowling Green a bronze level Bicycle Friendly Community – proclamation/ribbon cutting, free movie night at Capitol and Mayor's Bike Ride.
 - c. Duncan Hines Days FREE Stroll & Roll Parade, FREE community bike ride - Ride n' Dine/Atomic Kitchen, Friday Noon Cake Walk
 - d. BikeWalkBG School Bike Education – conducted programs at 11 schools, involving 38 classes and approx. 1,000 students during 2025-2026 school year. Will gear up for 2026-2027 this summer.

- A. Warren County Public Works – Josh Moore on the following projects Finalizing pavement plan with some increase this year; Roundabout at Dillard Rd and Bettersworth Rd; Slim island Rd from Hwy 185 to Jackson Orchard Rd.
- B. KYTC D3 –Joe Plunk provided updates on the following: Hwy 185; 31w to Mizpah Rd; US 31W bypass widening; Nashville Rd. widening, sidewalks and greenway; Woodburn roundabout; Three Springs Rd.; Annual maintenance including mowing, resurfacing and striping; 2026 Enacted Hwy plan that has unfunded phases of SPP projects on hold for further additional funding. Cave Mill Rd. and Fairview at Kereiakes Park are included in current SSP projects list
- C. City of Bowling Green Public Works – Kyle Hunt provided updates on the following projects: Thomason roundabout; Greenhill extension; Highland greenway; Smallhouse greenway; Cave Mill Rd design, and pavement preservation tests.
