ARTICLE III

Section 3: Alternate Members *(red text shows suggested added text)*

The KYTC District 3 Chief District Engineer *or designated alternate* shall serve as the alternate voting member to represent the Secretary of the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet in his/her absence.

The Public Works Director for the City of Bowling Green *or designated alternate* shall serve as the alternate voting member to represent the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green in his/her absence.

The Public Works Director for Warren County *or designated alternate* shall serve as the alternate voting member to represent the Judge-Executive of Warren County in his/her absence.

ARTICLE V

Section 2: Duties of Officers. *(red text shows suggested added text)*

The duties of the officers shall be as follows:

- Chair- It is the responsibility of the Chair *or alternate member* to preside at all meetings of the Policy Committee, to enforce all laws and regulations relating to the administration of the Policy Committee (PC), facilitate proper adherence to adopted procedures, call special meetings as required, and appoint all committees and subcommittees as needed with the concurrence of the Policy Committee (PC).
- Vice Chair- It is the responsibility of the Vice-Chair *or alternate member* to assist the Chair in the performance of his/her duties, and to perform the duties of the Chair in his/her absences.
